This month at Vision Illumination, we've been focused on problem-solving as well as adapting our products to meet unique project requirements of our clients.

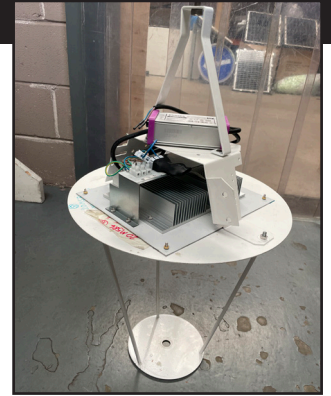

To solve this, we developed a new system, relocating the controller and battery to the column base for better weight distribution. We also designed a custom spigot to ensure a perfect fit. The result? A lightweight, tailored solution that met the council's needs.

This unit is now on trial with the council, and we look forward to receiving their feedback as we continue to refine and improve our solutions.
